



## Pharos HP Integrated MFP 2.4.9: Release Notes

This document contains the release notes for the 2.4.9 release of the Pharos HP Integrated MFP software. This release is compatible with version 7.2 and later of the Pharos Solution Suite as well as version 3.5 Release 2 and later of the Pharos Blueprint Enterprise and supports the following device models:

### Install Notes

#### 1. Recommended HP firmware version

The Pharos HP iMFP Application requires HP iMFPs to be running the latest firmware found at the HP website. As of January 2010 HP has just released new engine firmware for the M series devices. This updated firmware enhances the speed of authentication when run with the Pharos iMFP version 2.4.9 client. It is highly recommended that the latest HP firmware be applied to the engine.

### What's New in This Release

#### 1. Password-protected Jobs now raise errors when incorrect passwords used for print or delete

The defect has been fixed so that users are once again notified that the job was not successfully released.

#### 2. Copy count status overwritten by user balance

When the iMFP code is connected to Uniprint we show the user balance in the status line. On the HP copy screen this overwrites the status line where the copy application reports the copy status (eg. page 4 of 24). This prevents a user from walking up and seeing how many pages remain before a job is completed. In a case where user balance is not terribly important (HE/BO) this is detrimental.

This behavior is now configurable in the terminal configuration.

**3. Time synchronization can now be enabled/disabled in the terminal configuration**

At power-up the iMFP would synchronize it's time with the Uniprint server. This behavior is now configurable in the terminal configuration.

**4. Users with Insufficient Funds are denied login access despite having Cost Centers**

A number of improvements were made regarding users that had cost center access but a zero user balance (or no access to personal accounts).
